The 28th Annual Festival of Trees Homegrown Christmas is rapidly approaching and once again we are asking designers to create and donate little trees, wreaths, table centrepieces and other creative items for a silent auction at this event. Please consider this your invitation to volunteer your time and creativity to support the Spirit of the North Healthcare Foundation through our Festival of Trees. This year, we are continuing to do our best to celebrate the coming Christmas season.

Spirit of the North Healthcare Foundation's mission is to raise funds to support initiatives that will bring exceptional healthcare services and healthcare providers to Northern British Columbia. To date, over \$4.5 million has been raised at the Festival of Trees to benefit healthcare in the North. Some examples of equipment purchased using Festival funds are: Surgical Laser System, Emergency Room Crash Carts, MRI, Special Care Nursery/NICU & Pediatrics Equipment, Surgical Lights, Infusion pumps for chemotherapy, Ultrasound and Endoscope, Ophthalmology Equipment, and the Spect CT Scanner, Malditoff Mass Spectrometer, Breast Health Imaging Equipment, molecular Diagnostic Lab, and so much more.

The 28th Annual Festival of Trees opens on Friday, November 26th and runs until Sunday, December 5th at 4:00 pm. Enclosed you will find the Wreaths and Little Trees Designer Agreement. To indicate your participation in the event, and to ensure space is reserved for you, we need this completed Agreement returned to us as soon as possible or before Friday, November 5, 2021. The Agreement can be dropped off at the Foundation office located in the hospital lobby, faxed to (250) 565-2595, or emailed to spiritofthenorth@northernhealth.ca. Please retain a copy of the Agreement for your records.

Please note that all wreath, little tree and centrepiece materials must be obtained by the sponsor and/or designer and the cost incurred for every item or decoration will be the responsibility of the sponsor and/or designer. This includes the wreath or tree. If requested on the Agreement, a donation receipt will be issued for the Gift-in-Kind value of your donated items when original receipts are attached to the document. As space is limited, little trees must be no larger than 4 1/2 feet high and wreaths must be no larger than 30 inches in diameter.

This year, all donations need to be delivered to The Civic Centre on Wednesday, November 24th between 9:00 am and 9:00 pm. If this date does not work for you, please contact Leeann Cooper for alternate arrangements. Unfortunately, late submissions will not be accepted.

WREATH AND LITTLE TREE DESIGNER TIPS



Your wreath/tree should convey a cohesive theme. Suggestions include: children/teens (stuffed animals, movies), holiday (Nutcracker, reindeer), religious (angels, Nativity), nostalgic and classic Christmas (home-made goodies, holiday traditions), sparkly (glitter, twinkle lights), winter sports (skiing, hockey), outdoors (lake, lodge), Christmas in different climates (tropical, North Pole), fine arts (drawing, music), miscellaneous (wine, electronics, chocolate, coffee, gardening)...

Try to exceed the expectations of the audience. Excite the imagination of the viewer by including things like colour, sparkle, contrast, texture, an unexpected element.

Consider your prospective silent auction buyers. Most purchasers are individual buyers who are looking for wreaths or trees to decorate their personal home or the house of a family member. Some purchasers are business buyers who are looking for items that will enhance the business office, lobby or showroom. Some purchasers are looking for items to donate to their favourite non-profit organizations, schools or hospital departments.

Your beautiful wreath or tree will be picked up or moved an average of three times. All decorations, lights, etc. need to be wired to your donation with florist wire to prevent damage and to help ensure that it arrives to its final destination looking as good as it did upon delivery to The Civic Centre. A four inch piece of floral wire can be wrapped firmly and tightly around the decoration using two twists. Remember to use the same colour of wire as the colour of your wreath or tree. Ornaments with an inserted or slip-on hanging attachment must be glued where the two pieces meet so the ornament cannot slip off its hanger. Fragile glass ornaments should be used cautiously as they may break when the wreath or tree is moved.

A variety of materials can be used to fill empty spaces, add shape or cover a tree trunk. Suggestions include: baby's breath, garlands, ribbon wraps and bows, raffia, tulle, pine cones, dried flowers, a string of lights, etc.

Ribbon selection is important. Bows can give the finishing touch to your donation at a minimal cost. Florist wire ribbon is easiest to tie. Fabric ribbon is only printed on one side and is stiff and difficult to tie. Velvet is beautiful but because it is thick, and it is more difficult to tie. The wider the ribbon, the more yardage it takes to make a bow. It takes two or three yards to make a nice bow.

Attach a temporary tag to your creation so that the Festival Committee can match it with the permanent one that is being made for the Festival display. The tag should include the wreath or tree's name, business sponsor (if there is one) and designer name(s). Approximate value is also helpful so that a starting bid can be calculated.
